CEMETERY COMMISSION NEWS:

LAKE NEWS:

The planned improvements to water runoff drainage at the Spofford Lake boat ramp and parking area are being delayed. The supervising engineering company is unable to be present next week. The proposed work is expected to be done in late April, once dates can be fixed with engineers.

The Chesterfield Housing Working Group is working to define the existing housing stock and gathering data on housing needs and preferences for the future.
